Foreword

In order for Denton County to effectively prepare for and mitigate against the increasing hazards that pose a risk to the citizens and visitors of Denton County, it is necessary to recognize the changing hazards and vulnerabilities that face the County. The following hazard and vulnerability analysis will provide a tool for understanding the unique hazards and risks that are specific to our county.

The hazard and vulnerability analysis should be updated biennially (every two years) to keep pace with the changing dynamics of the county. It is also the intent that results of this analysis are used to develop hazard operations planning and target mitigation in order to minimize or eliminate the risk posed to Denton County.



Introduction

Denton County is vulnerable to many types of hazards including natural and technological triggering agents. The county has not experienced any major incidents in recent history. However, many minor emergencies have occurred such as: the February 11, 2010 winter storm which deposited up to 14.4 inches of snow and ice; the April 24, 2007 flash floods which dumped up to 10.5 inches of rain in areas of the county; the 2006 drought that affected the County and surrounding areas.¹ There have also been numerous other annual natural hazard events such as hail, tornadoes, lightning, and wildfires.

This comprehensive report identifies hazards and the subsequent risks facing Denton County. For the purpose of this report, we will define hazards in two groups, natural and technological. Natural hazards include severe thunderstorms, flooding, tornadoes, extreme temperatures, winter storms, and drought. The technological hazards include hazardous material (hazmat) spills, explosions, technology failures, and terrorist incidents. The risk associated with these hazards can include loss of life, injuries, and property damage. In cooperation with the Denton County GIS Department, we have identified the vulnerability of Critical Infrastructure and Key Resources (CIKR) such as schools, hospitals, utilities, government facilities, and other vulnerable populations.

The definition of certain terms will aid in understanding the context of this report. These terms include hazard, risk and vulnerability. Hazards to life and property in or near Denton County are addressed in this report. In some instances, populations as well as residential, commercial, and governmental structures are at risk based on their proximity to a hazard. Risk from technological hazards and some natural hazards are usually based on proximity. Other hazards such as tornadoes or drought can only be discussed on a regional basis rather than in terms of specific geographic location. Populations as well as residential, commercial, and governmental structures and associated infrastructure are defined as vulnerable to the extent they are subject to the hazards they have to potential to encounter.

Geophysical Description

Geography

Denton County covers 911 square miles in north central Texas. The Eastern Cross Timbers juts through the central part of the county. “Blackland Prairie” covers its western half and a slice along its eastern edge. The Elm Fork of the Trinity River flows through the county. The river was dammed in 1920 to form Lake Dallas, which has been expanded and is now known as Lewisville Lake. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers dammed the river farther upstream in 1986 to form Ray Roberts Lake. A greenbelt along the Elm Fork connects the two lakes. A number of state parks border the lakes.²

General Information

Denton embarked on a course that would make it a major higher education center when North Texas Normal College, now the University of North Texas (UNT) was established in 1890. Legislation authorizing the Girls College of Industrial Arts, now Texas Woman's University (TWU), was passed in 1901.²

Vital transportation links contributed more growth. Interstate 35 East (I-35E) was built in the 1950s, and joined by Interstate 35 West (I-35W) in the 1970s. Dallas-Fort Worth International Airport opened in January 1974. Alliance Airport, which straddles the Denton County-Tarrant County boundary in the southwest corner of the county, opened in December 1989 to trigger growth along I-35W. Texas Motor Speedway, one of the largest sports and entertainment facilities in the world, opened in 1997 along I-35W.²

County Population

By the end of the 20th century, over 400,000 people were living in an increasingly urban Denton County. The U.S. Census Bureau 2008 figures show Denton County’s population estimate at 636,557 people.³ NCTCOG and U.S. Census Bureau projections expect Denton County population to be over 1 million by the year 2030 (Fig. 1) – a 41% increase over 2010 estimates, and a 61% population increase over the 2000 Census count.^{3,4}

County Government

The Commissioners Court is the general governing body of Denton County. The Court consists of the County Judge, who is elected countywide and presides over the full Court, and four County Commissioners – each elected from one of the County's four precincts.⁵

The four County Commissioners have both countywide and precinct responsibilities. Each commissioner is responsible for construction and maintenance of County roads within his or her precinct. Some Commissioners maintain offices both at the Courthouse-On-The-Square and within their precincts. They are responsive to the particular needs of people living within their areas of the County.

Despite the name, the Commissioners Court is not a judicial court. Each commissioner is responsible for construction and maintenance of County roads within his or her precinct, and serves as a liaison to a particular board or agency of the County.⁵

Employment

The public and private sectors in and around Denton County currently employ approximately 354,741 Denton County residents.⁶ This number is well ahead of projections from the 2000 Census in which the bureau estimated 2010 county employment at 228,191 persons, as listed on the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) website.⁷

UNT is the largest employer in Denton County with 7,762 employees.⁸ Twelve firms within the county employ 1000+ employees, nineteen firms employ between 500-999 persons, and more than forty-five firms employ 250-499 persons. In addition, Denton County historically carries a lower unemployment rate than either the state or national unemployment rate.⁶

Industry

Denton County contains a diverse industry base. The last U.S. Census Bureau Economic survey identified 10,894 firms within the county in 2007.⁹ These included manufacturing, petroleum based, retail, utilities, education, healthcare, and many other product and service providers. In addition to UNT, some of the other large employers (1000+) within the county are: Lewisville (5,896 jobs) and Denton (2,948 jobs) Independent School Districts (LISD and DISD, respectively), American Airlines Alliance Maintenance (2,105 jobs), Wal-Mart (2,035 jobs), Frito-Lay (2,000 jobs), TWU (1,586 jobs), Peterbilt Motors (1,500 jobs), and Denton State School (1,500 jobs).⁷ County and local governments also account for well over 5,000 jobs in Denton County.⁹

Transportation

The County of Denton contains multiple hazards secondary to the transportation infrastructure. Contained within the county is I-35, which consists of four lanes and runs north/south from the northern central edge of Denton County to the west side of Denton. I-35 then splits into I-35W (north-northeast to south-southwest) to Fort Worth, and I-35E (north-northwest to south-southeast) to Dallas. I-35E varies from four lanes to six lanes in some areas. U.S. Highway 121 (toll road) runs south-southwest to north-northeast across the southeastern corner of Denton County. U.S. Highway 114 consists of two and four lanes, and runs east-west to south-southeastern, from the southwestern edge to the central southern portion of the county. US Highway 380, which runs east and west through the central portion of Denton County, consists of two and four lane roads. US Highway 377 consists of two and four lanes, and runs south-southwest to north-northeast from the southwestern edge to the northeastern edge of the county. Farm Road 156 (FM-156) consists of two lanes and runs south-southwest to north-northeast from the southwestern edge to the central northern portion of the county where it ties into I-35. The following traffic counts have been recorded:

Development

Demographics and land use records show Denton County consists of 610,108 acres of total land. Current data shows 34.2% of land within the County is developed or under construction.¹¹ Demographic development categories include residential (single and multi-family), mobile homes/group quarters, industrial, commercial, institutional, infrastructure, parks and floodplain, water bodies, and under construction categories. The remaining undeveloped land may allow Denton County to accommodate the projected population increases of the next few decades. However, many critical decisions will need to be made concerning land use and hazard impact.

Natural Hazards

Extreme Temperatures

Extreme temperatures are defined as temperatures that exceed normal highs or lows for an extended period, causing environmental damage and posing health risks. Scope of damage from extreme temperatures is dependent on the length and severity of the temperature extreme.

Historical data provided by the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration's (NOAA) National Climatic Data Center (NCDC), shows that extreme temperatures account for the largest number of weather related fatalities (56) within Denton County since July 1, 1996.¹² NOAA began collecting national fatality data for extreme temperatures in 1986. For the period 1986-2008, the number one killer of weather related fatalities in the United States is temperature extremes.¹³ It is important to note that the statistics for heat and cold related deaths are historically underreported because "cause of death" determinations are subject to a doctor or coroner's professional opinion, and they may not connect the cause of death with temperature extremes in all situations, whereas death from drowning or lightning strikes are easily attributable to the specific hazard.

There are several mitigation measures that individuals can take to protect against extreme temperatures. People are encouraged to stay indoors with air conditioning/heating to avoid the dangers of extreme temperatures. People should avoid strenuous work outside when temperatures are high, especially the elderly, young children, and those with health problems.

Children and the elderly are particularly vulnerable to extreme temperatures; therefore, they should not be outside in such situations for extended periods. People are encouraged to drink adequate amounts of water to maintain hydration, and help their bodies handle extremely warm temperatures.

Severe Thunderstorms/Hail/Lightning

Thunderstorms are annual occurrences in Denton County. They occur year round, but the peak season for these storms occurs in the spring. Characteristics of "Severe" thunderstorms include heavy rain, strong winds (>58 mph), hail (at least 3/4 -inch), lightning, flash flooding, and/or tornadoes. Thunderstorms and their combined characteristics kill more people in the United States than any other phenomenon (Note: this combines the death tolls for flood, lightning, wind event and tornado fatalities). As many as 45,000 thunderstorms occur each day on our planet, and from these some 20 million lightning ground strikes are recorded.

The most effective mitigation measure will continue to be public education and warning. Inform the public with information about severe weather hazards and avoidance techniques. Information should provide facts and dispel common weather related myths. Also, include

actions to take such as staying indoors and tuning in to local news through TV or Radio. Public awareness should include information about NOAA Weather Radios, which disseminates specific information affecting the area in which the radio is located. Local insurance companies can help develop public information videos and brochures. Other mitigation efforts might include the building of, or continuing, relationships with the local Denton County Amateur Radio Association (DCARA) or Radio Amateur Civil Emergency Service (RACES), and the National Weather Service (NWS). In addition, the appropriate use of technology, such as the Emergency Alert System (EAS) or Reverse-911 system can enhance mitigation efforts and survivability.

Tornadoes

Denton County is located in the southern portion of what is known as “Tornado Alley,” which stretches through the Midwest. An average of 124 tornadoes touch Texas soil each year and of these, an average of 2 tornadoes per year touchdown in Denton County.¹⁴ Tornadoes may occur in any month and at any hour of the day. They occur most frequently during the early summer months between the hours of 4:00pm and 8:00pm. Most tornadoes move from southwest to northeast, although they can move in any direction.

The most effective mitigation for tornadoes is aggressive public education for schools and businesses. Mitigation might include integrating and improving warning systems, including outdoor warning systems, cable/satellite interrupt services, NWS/NOAA, AM/FM radio, and local television networks, and development of programs and training that include DCARA/RACES storm spotters. Other mitigation efforts are hardened construction on new County-owned and DISD buildings. Structural mitigation includes tornado roof straps that can be used in residential and commercial buildings. Construction and awareness of “safe rooms” can be integrated into new developments. In addition, non-structural mitigation such as changes to and enforcement of building codes aids in damage prevention.

Flooding

Flooding is a very dynamic event that is constantly changing as a result of land development. Development of land in a watershed will result in an increase of water entering into a drainage system. The increase in drainage water will affect the watershed and alter it from its previous condition. Flooding in some areas may become worse over time. This phenomenon makes it difficult to determine whether the cause of flooding is a natural or man-made condition.

The federal government maintains floodplain maps. These maps designate areas of land into floodplains of different potential. Some areas of land may be designated as being in a 50-year, 100-year, or 500-year floodplain. These designations represent a potential for flooding in the respective floodplain. For example, a 100-year floodplain means that there is a 1% likelihood of that area being flooded to a certain level during any given year.

The County also participates in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). Continued mapping and identification of historical high water problems is necessary. Public education regarding high water crossings should be included in any community awareness program. Flood studies of water-runoff caused by development outside the county should be considered.

Denton County employs five methods of reducing flood losses in accordance with the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance¹⁵:

1. Restrict or prohibit uses that are dangerous to health, safety or property in times of flood, or cause excessive increases in flood heights or velocities;
2. Require that uses vulnerable to floods, including facilities which serve such uses, be protected against flood damage at the time of initial construction;
3. Control the alteration of natural floodplains, stream channels, and natural protective barriers, which are involved in the accommodation of flood waters;
4. Control filling, grading, dredging and other development which may increase flood damage;
5. Prevent or regulate the construction of flood barriers which will unnaturally divert flood waters or which may increase flood hazards to other lands.

Winter Storms

Winter storms have affected Denton County and the surrounding areas 24 times since 1994.¹ These winter storms might include severe ice buildup, which can paralyze the County and its cities/towns. Results of winter and ice storms can include disruption of traffic, business and school closures, major utility outages, and illness or loss of life. There have been 10 deaths directly attributed to winter storms in Denton County between 1994 and 2010.¹

Since 1994, winter storms have accounted for \$67.13 million in reported property damage. The winter storm on February 24, 2003 caused \$15 million in property damage, and the heavy snows of February 11, 2010 resulted in \$2.0 million in property damage. Figures are not available for the economic impact or tax revenue loss due to business closures, utility outages, or the loss of income by parents forced to remain home from work with children due to school closures.¹

Denton County has no set policies or equipment designated for snow and ice removal in response to winter storms. Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) handles winter storm response for state highways and interstates, and local municipalities are responsible for roads inside their purview. Response from TxDOT and municipalities can include sanding of roads prior to or after an event. In addition, streets may be closed when necessary to prevent accidents. Contingency planning is necessary for extremely cold weather. This may include the need to open emergency shelters. Special population identification, such as the homeless and elderly,

should be made prior to any incident. Working relationships with various agencies should be fostered.

Drought

Since 1996, Denton County and surrounding areas have suffered 23 drought events totaling more than \$2.681 billion in crop and property damage.¹ Agricultural drought is a condition of climate dryness, which is severe enough to reduce soil moisture and water below the minimum necessary to sustain plant, animal, and human life. Hydrologic drought is a long-term condition of abnormally dry weather that ultimately leads to depletion of surface and ground water supplies – the drying up of rivers and streams, and the cessation of spring flows. Denton County is primarily concerned with agricultural and hydrologic drought:

Drought mitigation consists of providing public information, upgrading water systems, and implementing water usage and/or rationing standards during a drought.

Wildfires/Grassfires

Denton County, as well as the rest of Texas, is experiencing rapid population growth and development. Throughout Texas, the majority of the state's new development is encroaching on undeveloped wildland areas. The area where homes and structures intersect with undeveloped wildland areas that contain flammable grass, brush and trees is known as the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI). Wildfire occurrence statistics in Texas show that people cause more than 95 percent of all the wildfires, and more than 80 percent of all the wildfires in Texas occur within two miles of an established community.¹⁶ From December 2005 to June 2010, there were 562 separate fire events resulting in one fatality within Denton County, as documented by the Texas Forest Service and NCDC (accurate cost projection data was unavailable).

Denton County employs a multifaceted approach to wildfire/grassfire mitigation. Fuel reduction through thinning of vegetation, aggressive mowing schedules, and controlled-burns limits fuel available for fire events. Firewise landscaping and construction techniques (<http://firewise.org/>), area burn bans, and many other prevention techniques can help reduce fire events and their impact on the manufactured environment. Public information campaigns targeting local schools, businesses, and Home Owner Associations (HOA), as well as residents themselves can prove invaluable.

Technological Hazards

Major Hazardous Materials Incident

Hazardous materials incidents are those occasions where a toxic substance is released from its original container and has the potential to cause harm to people, property, or the environment. This material can take the form of solid, liquid, or gas. Scope of damage from this type of incident depends upon the type of release, area the release occurs, time of day, and severity of the release.

Denton County's hazmat response capability can be summarized as follows: Denton Fire Department Hazardous Materials Entry Team, Lewisville Fire Department Hazardous Materials Decontamination Team, Flower Mound Fire Department Hazardous Materials Decontamination Team, and Krum Fire Department Hazardous Materials Logistical Support Team. All local jurisdictions within Denton County are party to agreements that lend resources under an all-hazards approach to combat any incident that exceeds another jurisdiction's capability.

In addition to intra-county cooperation, the Texas Statewide Mutual Aid System provides integrated statewide mutual aid response capability between local government entities without a requirement for written mutual aid agreements.

Pipeline Rupture

The State of Texas has more than 250,000 miles of pipeline. In 2006, Denton County had over 2,000 oil and gas wells connected through flow lines to the statewide pipeline collection and distribution network. That number has steadily increased over the years. Supply pipelines connecting to residential and commercial structures plumbed for natural gas also pose a risk. There have been many explosions in recent years throughout the region from industrial, commercial, and residential pipeline applications resulting in numerous deaths, severe injuries, and catastrophic property damage. Construction crews are generally the cause of pipeline ruptures; however, soil movement and pipeline deterioration from age cause ruptures also.

Effective mitigation against pipeline rupture includes close supervision of construction crews that are digging. Updated line mapping will also aid in the reduction of ruptures. Odorants added to natural gas lines can increase the ability to detect leaks and secure flow before a catastrophic rupture or explosion occurs. Public information campaigns, such as how to shut off a building's gas main, and the "Texas 811" One-Call System are also effective.

Terrorist Incident/Bio/Chem/Nuclear

A terrorist incident is a violent act, or an act dangerous to human life, in violation of the criminal laws of the United States or of any state, to intimidate or coerce a government, the civilian population, or any segment thereof, in furtherance of political, religious, or social objectives. These terrorist acts may include Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD) such as biological, chemical, or radiological agents.

The Dallas-Fort Worth area is considered one of the country's top targets for terrorism. The newly constructed Cowboy Stadium in Arlington, Texas, is a prime location for major sporting events such as the Super Bowl, along with the area being a major population center. In Denton County, we also have one of the largest sports venues, Texas Motor Speedway. In addition, The attempt in September of 2009, by a Hosam Maher Husein Smadi, a Jordanian man, to detonate a vehicle filled with explosives in front of a Dallas high-rise building reinforces our need to remain vigilant.

Terrorism mitigation comes in two forms: Counter-terrorism and Anti-terrorism. Counter-terrorism is any offensive measure taken to prevent, deter, preempt, and respond to terrorism. Anti-terrorism is any defensive measure intended to reduce the chance of a terrorist attack, or to reduce the vulnerability of possible targets to such tactics.

Working groups, specialized training, target hardening (such as barriers, increased security, or explosion/damage-resistant engineering techniques), exercises, and vigilance are required to provide the best protection against terrorist action. Public information concerning threat levels and telltale signs of terrorist activity can increase the chances of preventing an incident through agency and citizen awareness.



Natural Hazard Identification

Natural hazards facing Denton County are numerous. The analyses of natural hazard risks are based on the frequency of events and its associated damage, loss of life, or injury. Natural hazard data encompasses all relevant data available between January 1, 1950 to July 1, 2010. Annotations have been made in the tables, where the date range is restricted due to available data. Due to the volume of hazard events (1,277), detailed summaries of each event have not been included in this HVA. Technological Hazard Identification

Denton County had 40 reportable hazmat incidents between January 5, 2004 and March 4, 2010.¹⁷ Technological hazards within the county are generally the result of hazardous materials traveling through the city via highways, railway, air and gas lines. However, there are also fixed sites throughout the county that pose a risk. Fixed site hazards are based on reporting requirements put in place by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. The site hazards discussed within this report includes facilities that reported under the federal law Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA), Title III, Section 312, Tier II reporting. Tier II facilities are those that process, store or dispose of specific chemicals in quantities deemed to present a public risk.

Risk Assessment

Populations as well as residential, commercial and government structures are vulnerable to natural hazards. For hazards such as flooding, this vulnerability is based on elevation and proximity to waterways, drainage and flood control systems. For other hazards such as tornadoes, severe thunderstorms, hail and extreme temperatures the vulnerability can only be characterized on a broad regional basis.

Similarly, populations and residential, commercial and government structures are vulnerable in the areas surrounding established hazardous materials transportation routes and chemical handling facilities. This vulnerability is based on proximity to the hazard.

For the purpose of this Risk Assessment and Vulnerability Analysis, the following approach was used to define risk areas within Denton County.


- **Natural Hazard**

- 100 Year Flood Zones: Areas in the community that have been identified as susceptible to a one-percent-probability of flooding in any given year.

- **Technological Hazards**

- Highways, pipelines, and railroads are used to transport hazardous materials. The Department of Transportation (DOT) Emergency Response Guidebook (ERG) – a guidebook for first responders during the initial phase of a dangerous goods/hazardous materials incident – was used as the source for establishing the risk area criteria. Specifically, the Table of Initial Isolation and Protective Action Distances section of the guidebook, identified 3000 feet as the greatest, “first isolate in all directions,” distance for a large spill. Using that 3000-foot zone as the basis, a risk area 3000 feet on either side of a railway approved for the transport of hazardous materials was used in this study.
- Denton County does not contain any designated hazardous material roadway routes. However, quantities of hazardous materials do move through the county’s roadways. Therefore, a 1000-foot risk zone on either side of the roadway is used. The 1000-foot risk zone from the ERG has also been adopted around facilities that report to the EPA under SARA Title III, Section 312, Tier II reporting.
- In accordance with the ERG, 330 foot buffers are adopted for oil and gas wells, and pipelines. Table 8 (page 19) will list all Tier II fixed sites and the associated chemicals and compounds they store. Table 8 will also list the range for the maximum and daily average amounts of each chemical or compound onsite by weight.








HAZARD ASSESSMENT: OIL/GAS WELLS (ACTIVE)






RISK ASSESSMENT: PUBLIC SCHOOLS
