## ARTWORK RELEASE

To: SOAR Team – Juvenile Mental Health Court, Denton County (collectively the “**Event Sponsors**”)

In consideration of my child’s participation in the “SOAR” logo art contest, I, for myself and/or on behalf of my child/children acknowledge, represent and agree to the following:

1. I waive any right I may have to inspect or approve the finished Artwork in any display, marketing or other promotional materials, as applicable.

I understand that neither I, nor my child shall receive any compensation for my child’s Artwork being used for any purpose, including but not limited to use in any promotional materials by the Event Sponsors. I and my child guarantee that the consent of no other person or other entity is required to enable the Event Sponsors to use the Artwork. I represent and warrant that such use of the Artwork by the Event Sponsors will not violate or infringe upon the intellectual property rights, artistic and/or other rights of any third parties. The rights granted in this Artwork Release include the right to use the Artwork in any publication, display, advertising or recording throughout the world in perpetuity in all media, for purposes of promoting the Event Sponsors.
4. ***I hereby agree to fully indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Event Sponsors, their successors, officers, directors, agents, assigns and/or employees from any and all legal claims, proceedings, and/or liabilities of any description that may be asserted, directly or indirectly, arising from the Event Sponsors’ use of the Artwork (including without limitation any and all claims that the Event Sponsors’ use, access, or involvement infringes or impermissibly incorporates any of the intellectual property rights of any third party), and/or my child/children’s breach of this Artwork Release, including unauthorized use of the Artwork.***

The SOAR Logo Art Contest is an activity to raise awareness about children's mental health in Denton County. We encourage aspiring artists 10-17 years of age living in Denton County to participate in this art contest as we recognize the importance of mental health to every person in our community.

## Student Eligibility

The art contest is open to all youth (10-17 years of age) in Denton County.

## Participation Requirements

- The artwork should represent what SOAR means to the artist. SOAR is the name of the new Juvenile Mental Health Court in Denton County. The artwork will become the logo for SOAR.
- The Entry Forms must be complete with signatures and all contact information requested. Attach the entry forms to all entries.
- All entries must be the product of the teen's creativity. This art contest is designed to encourage each youth to express him or herself. Help from an adult is not allowed.
- Use of copyrighted material is prohibited. Plagiarized entries will be disqualified. *Plagiarism* is defined as taking and using another person's ideas, writings, or inventions as one's own.

## How to Submit

## Art Guidelines

Arts include many art forms that are visual in nature. The artist (youth submitting an entry) is a person who captures their own thoughts and ideas to create a visual piece of art.

Accepted forms of visual art include: original print, drawing, painting, collage, computer-generated, or photography. Artwork entries must be 2D.

Each entry must be the original work of a youth currently residing in Denton County. Artwork must not exceed 24x30 inches, including matting. Artwork must be flat and not more than 1 inch thick. Framed artwork not accepted. Label back of entry with artist name, grade, and title of artwork. Attach the completed Entry Forms to the back of the artwork.
