## FM 2450 Pavement Improvement Project Has Broken Ground

DENTON COUNTY – The Texas Department of Transportation is breaking ground this month on a project to improve pavement on the entire length of FM 2450 from FM 156 in Krum north to where it terminates at Gregory Road in northwest Denton County. The mostly rural road is one lane in each direction and stretches 11.5 miles.

The project includes base repair and overlay and will require daily lane closures. Since the road only has one lane in each direction, traffic will be flagged around the construction. Lane closures will generally be between 8:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday with the road re-opening to two lanes after 3:30 p.m.. There will be occasional Saturday work.

Jagoe Public Company of Denton is the contractor on the \$2.06 million project. The project is expected to be substantially complete by September 2012.

TxDOT would like to thank area drivers for their patience and cooperation as crews work diligently to complete this project as safely and as soon as possible.
